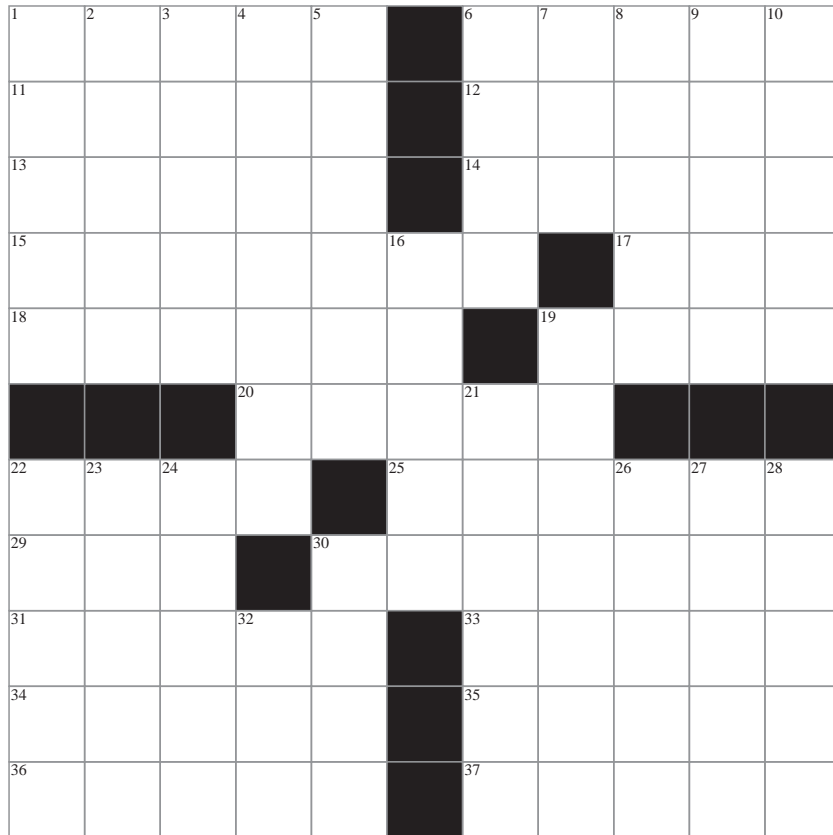


ACROSS
